WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 19 to 25 SEPT 2016

DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)

On 22 Sep 16, a transport truck backed into a loading dock in 100 Mile House and damaged the contents of the trailer causing one tote of sodium hydroxide to start leaking. Most of the contents remained inside the truck but some leaked out onto the ground. The sodium hydroxide mixed with substances in the truck, producing gas. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) and attended the site. A nearby elementary school was closed for the day as a precautionary measure while the Fire Department and Hazmat Contractor laid sand to form a berm, neutralized the material and unloaded the trailer.

On 23 Sep 16, a fishing boat (Naden Isle) caught fire off of Tofino. The vessel was reported to have 350 gallons of diesel, 15 gallons of motor oil, 30 gallons of hydraulic oil, and two 30lb propane tanks on board. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) with immediate down grade, due to the potential for pollution in a environmentally sensitive area.

On 24 Sep 16, more than 100,000 gallons of material contained in a Canfor settling pond spilled into Centurian Creek, in Chetwynd. The Emergency Program Coordinator advised that Public Works had been in contact with Canfor and the creek did not affect the town's water supply. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) and indicated that a sheen was observed on the water 1.5 kilometres downstream from the saw mill. The discharge ceased, an inspection found no significant environmental impact however Canfor was following up with sampling.
