BODY RECOVERY

On 23 July 16, Quesnel SAR responded at the request of the Coroner, to recover a body near the Pinnacle Road Provincial Park in Quesnel.

On 24 July 16, North Shore Rescue responded at the request of the Coroner, to recover a body at the base of Cleveland Dam.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 18 July 16, there was a fire at a saw mill in Port Moody resulting in the possible release of fire suppression materials to the marine. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to possible pollution and potential for heightened media attention.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 22 July 16, the Vernon EPC reported that they had a brush and wildfire burning near residences in the Silver Star area. The BX Swan Lake Fire Department (FD) was the first to respond and the Vernon FD provided mutual aid. ESS was put on standby in case any residences were threatened if the wind picked up however, no ESS volunteers were engaged. TASK 171974
