BODY RECOVERY

On 23 June 2017, Quesnel SAR responded to a request from the RCMP on behalf of the Coroner to recover a body.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 22 June 2017, a barge loaded with over forty vehicles caught fire at the Jutland Road, Ellis Recycling Facility. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential for pollution and due to heightened media attention.

LANDSLIDE

On 19 June 2017, a landslide occurred in Williams Lake that washed out a 150' wide section of Highway 20, 30 Km west of town, near the English Bridge.

On 21 June 2017, a landslide occurred in the Columbia Shuswap Regional District at 5783 Sunnybrae Canoe Point Road.

On June 24 2017 a landslide occurred in the Central Kootenay Regional District at Mount Buchanan in Kaslo.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 25 June 2017, an incident was opened for a dog that went over Shannon Falls, near Squamish and was stranded on a ledge. To prevent the owner from harming herself trying to rescue the pet herself, SAR was requested to assist in recovering the dog from the ledge. SAR stood down when the dog was rescued by others.
