BODY RECOVERY

On Jun 10 2017, Grand Forks SAR responded at the request of the Coroner to conduct a body recovery in the Grand Forks area.

FLOODING

On 05 June 2017, an incident was opened for the Central Kootenay Regional District (CKRD) due to flooding in Riondel on Tamosanter Creek.

On 05 June 2017, an incident was opened for properties east of Main Street in Ollala, within the Okanagan Similkameen Regional District (OSRD), abutting Keremeos Creek.

On 05 June 2017, an incident was opened for the first nations community of Ts'Kw'Awlaxw due to flooding in the Pavilion area, near Lillooet.

On 05 June 2017, an incident was opened for the Thompson Nicola Regional District (TNRD) due to flooding that impacted one resident in the Canford area of Nicola Lake.

On 05 June 2017, an incident was opened for the Penticton Indian Band who were experiencing flooding near at the Red Wing Resort, Penticton.

On 06 June 2017, an incident was opened to support response efforts related to flooding in the City of Peachland.

On 06 June 2017, an incident was opened due to flooding that required an evacuation alert to be issued for the Lakeshore Road area in Vernon.

On 06 June 2017, an incident was opened to support the Okanagan Similkameen Regional District (OSRD), to issue a Declaration of a State of Local Emergency due to flooding in the area of Red Wing Resort.

On 08 June 2107, an incident was opened in Naramata for an evacuation of residents due to high water levels in the Mill Road area.

On 09 June 2017, an incident was opened for the Regional District of Bulkley Nechako due to potential flooding and a flood watch on the Bulkley River.

On 10 June 2017, an incident was opened for the North Okanagan Regional District (NORD) due to flooding on Johnson Creek near Mara Lake.

On 10 June 2017, an incident was opened for the Peace River Regional District (PRRD) due to flooding on the Pine River.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 05 June 2017, Creston Fire Rescue responded to a medical assist after a motorist fell over a steep embankment near 4629 Osborne Road in the Erickson area.

On 07 June 2017, Archipelago SAR responded to Tow Hill (Masset) to assist with a possible animal rescue where a small dog fell 300 feet down a steep embankment.

On 07 June 2017, Creston Fire Rescue responded to extricate two occupants of a crashed ultralight aircraft in the Canyon Lister area.

On 08 June 2017, a family of four was displaced from their residence due to a police incident. The family was provided accommodation for one night while the residence was classified as a 'crime scene'.
