BODY RECOVERY

On 16 Sep 2017, Arrow Lakes SAR responded to assist the Coroner to recover a body that was located at the 7 km mark of the Fish River FSR underneath a log. It is believed to be the subject of a search in the Beaton area, from a month prior.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 12 Sep 2017, an incident was opened for the East Kootenay Regional District, to issue an evacuation alert due to the threat of a wildland fire in the Quinn Creek area (N11664).

MISCELLANEOUS

On 12 Sep 2017, a task number was created to allow for the provision of ESS support to individuals displaced to BC from out-of-province wildfires.

On 17 Sep 2017, an incident was opened to provide ESS for 7 people who were displaced when a car ran into their home in Kamloops.
