DANGEROUS GOODS

On 02 Mar 2017 RCMP discovered a Clandestine Super Lab in a rural location in Rock Cr. Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to potential risk to public safety.

ON 04 Mar 2017 A truck transporting Difluoroethane was located on its side near Heather Mt Lodge in Golden. Ministry of Environment (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to potential risk to public safety.

On 04 March there was an employee at the Burdwood Fish Farms in Echo bay that accidentally left the diesel pump open causing 3000 litres of diesel to go to the fish farm. Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to potential risk to environment and public safety.

BODY RECOVERY

On 02 March 2017 RCMP requested SAR to help with a body recovery on the north side of the Malahat near Bamberton. Cowichan Valley and Salt Spring Island SAR aided with the extrication of the body.
