## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 06-12 FEB 2017**

### **SEVERE STORM**

On 09 Feb 17, the District of Squamish opened up their EOC to support work crews dealing with issues resulting from an ongoing storm event of heavy snow transitioning into freezing rain.

On 09 Feb 17, the District of Mission activated their EOC to Level 1 to deal with a winter storm event. Additional concerns were that their regional dispatch communications were down, which resulted in them using cell phones.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 06 Feb 17, the East Kootenay Regional District opened a warming centre in Elko to accommodate people stranded by the closure of Hwy 3.

On 09 Feb 17, the Central Kootenay Regional District activated their EOC due to the overwhelming number of calls for assistance from residents that have been cut off due to winter storm.

On 09 Feb 17, the Fraser Valley Regional District activated their EOC to Level 1 to deal with several communities isolated due to snow and ice.

On 09 Feb 17, the District of Golden activated their EOC to Level 1 as they were working in conjunction with MoTI for avalanche assessment and control of Selkirk Hill in Golden.

On 09 Feb 17 the East Kootenay Regional District activated their EOC to Level 1 and subsequently opened a warming centre in Fernie to assist residents and travelers stranded due to the winter storm and Highway 3 closure.

On 09 Feb 17, The Thompson Nicola Regional District activated their EOC as a result of the winter storm and closure of Highway 5 between Merritt and Hope.

### **BODY RECOVERY**

On 10 Feb 17, Castlegar, Grand Forks, and Rossland SAR members responded to assist RCMP with the recovery of a deceased snowmobiler west of Nancy Greene Lake, near Trail.

### **EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 12 Feb 17, Hope SAR members responded at the request of the RCMP to conduct an evidence search in the Nahatlatch area, near Boston Bar.
