DANGEROUS GOODS

On 23 Jan 17, Crew Energy advised that they had an uncontrolled leak of produced water from a wellhead at a sweet gas well site near Chetwynd, following an equipment failure. OGC activated their EOC in Fort St. John, and the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status).

On 24 Jan 17, a mystery sheen on the Fraser River was reported by Global News. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to heightened media attention.
