WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Nov 13 – 19, 2017

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 13 Nov 2017, a tanker truck transporting Caustic Alkali hit the concrete barrier on Highway 1 at Rogers Pass. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to possible environmental impact and potential for heightened media attention.

On 15 Nov 2017, a logging truck went off the road on a logging road in Lake Cowichan and ended up submerged in Nixon Creek with the driver in the cab. It was also leaking an unknown amount of diesel fuel into the creek. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to possible environmental impact and potential for heightened media attention.

On 15 Nov 2017, a distinct strong diesel smell that had been occurring for 24 hours was reported at 1204 Main Street, Squamish. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) on 16 Nov 2017 due to possible environmental impact and potential for heightened media attention.

On 18 Nov 2017, the engine and cab of a semi hauling UN 1268 caught fire on Hwy 29 at Bennett Road near Fort St. John. No injuries were reported. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to possible environmental impact and potential for heightened media attention.

ROCKSLIDE

On 17 Nov 2017, EMBC was made aware of a rockslide that happened on 05 November 2017 in the Kent District. The slide took out an unattached garage. A geo-tech from FLNRO responded between Nov 11th and 12th to assess the situation.

FLOODING

On 19 Nov 2017, a home within Nanaimo Regional District flooded near French Creek due to a combination of excessive rainfall and high tide.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 19 Nov 2017, Prince Rupert SAR members responded to rescue a cat that had been stuck in a tree for 4 days, near 1816 Ken Avenue East in Prince Rupert.
