## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 16 - 22 Oct 2017**

### **DANGEROUS GOODS**

On the 17 Oct 2017, an ammonia leak at the Fernie Memorial Arena resulted in three fatalities. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer. The City of Fernie declared a State of Local Emergency and issued an Evacuation Order. First responders with support from local Search and Rescue conducted an evacuation of the immediate area. The Regional District of East Kootenay (RDEK) activated their Emergency Operations Centre and Emergency Social Services Reception Centre in support of approximately 56 evacuees from the area.

### **FLOODING**

On 18 Oct 2017, an incident was issued to the NEA PREOC to cover response and support to local authorities impacted by fall flooding.

On 18 Oct 2017, an NEA INAC Fall Flooding incident was generated for tracking response activities resulting from impacted First Nations.

On 18 Oct 2017, a flood incident was opened for the Wuikinuxv First Nations, within the Central Coast Regional District.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 17 Oct 2017, the District of Summerland activated their EOC to a level 1 in response to a severe storm that resulted in a power outage from downed power lines, trees hitting buildings and impacts to their sewer treatment and water treatment plants.

On 17 Oct 2017, a warming centre was set up in Sparwood for 30 – 40 people who were stranded as a result of a fire that closed off Highway 3 near Coleman, Alberta.

On 19 Oct 2017, the Salmon Arm Rescue Unit responded to BCAS request to use their extrication tools to gain access to an unresponsive man who was found in a locked vehicle in Salmon Arm.

On 22 Oct 2017, the Kimberly SAR team responded to rescue a dog that was stranded near Meachen Falls, in the Salmon Arm area.
