## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Oct 30 – Nov 05 2017**

### **DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 31 October 2017, a garbage truck that caught fire the previous day in Cumberland was still smoldering as the local fire department continued fire suppression activities. Some fire-fighting foam reached a nearby wetland but was believed to be environmentally friendly. Absorbent was applied where 2-3 gallons of oil spilled to the ground. Any remaining fuel onboard was to be offloaded prior to the removal and disposal of the truck, once it was safe to do so. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes with an immediate downgrade.

On 02 Nov 2017, a “growing sheen” was reported at the Delta Port in Ladner. The sheen was suspected to be from a spill of bunker fuel. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to possible environmental impact and potential for heightened media attention, however the incident was downgraded, the Canadian Coast Guard reported that no fuel spill could be located.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 4 Nov 17, a police incident in Kamloops required the tactical evacuation of an estimated 200 residents near the Tournament Inn.

### **POWER OUTAGE**

On 03 Nov 2017, an incident was issued for the Little Shuswap Indian Band to activate a warming/comfort centre for residents left without power for the majority of the day.
