## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 25 Sep – 1 Oct 2017**

### **DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 27 Sep 2017, a pumper truck rolled and entered the Beaton River at the 20km mark of the Mile 135 Road, at the Beaton River Bridge approximately 125 km northwest of Fort St. John. The truck was not carrying any dangerous goods but had equipment on board that contained 1000 Litres of hydraulic fluid and other engine fluids that had leaked into the river. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status).

On 27 Sep 2017, an ammonia leak at the Saputo facility on Lougheed Highway in Burnaby prompted the immediate evacuation of less than 50 employees. Once the company's engineer and Local Fire Hazmat team confirmed that the level on the metre had decreased to 2PPM, employees were allowed back into the building and a contractor attended to conduct repairs. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status), with an immediate downgrade, for notification purposes.

### **EVIDENCE SEARCH**

On 28 Sep 2017 Hope SAR responded to assist the police to search for evidence in an area approximately 30 KM from Hope.
