INTERFACE FIRE

On 19 Sep 2017, a task was issued to cover the hiring of a recovery manager due to wildfire impacts, which caused the community of Wells to suffer social and economic loss.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 22 Sept 2017, a task was issued to Quesnel SAR to search the Nazko area in an attempt to locate evidence.

On 18 Sep 2017, a task was issued to Chilliwack SAR to retrieve a stranded dog off of an island, in the Fraser River at the end of Gil road.
