WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Nov 27 – Dec 03, 2017

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 28 Nov 2017, a fire involving a tanker truck hauling a corrosive glue-like liquid substance resulted in the closure of the Coquihalla Highway in both directions, near Hope. The fire was located between the truck and cargo containers and caused the contents to spill to the environment. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) while environmental responders worked to secure the spilled material. The highway was reopened later that evening and the incident was downgraded by MOE.

On 29 Nov 2017, a report of diesel in a nearby ditch was found near a heritage building undergoing construction work in North Vancouver. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to significant media attention after it was discovered to be from an underground storage tank.

On 29 Nov 2017, a report of farm fish blood being dumped into the ocean was raised to a Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to significant media attention. The incident was then downgraded to a Code 1, once the notifications were disseminated.

On 2 Dec 2017, 19 CN Rail cars derailed between Savona and Walachin near the Thompson River, spilling red wheat grain. The MOE RO raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to potential media attention.

On Dec 3 Dec 2017, an explosion occurred at a sour gas well site outside of Fort St John. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to media attention and public safety concerns.

FLOODING

On 28 Nov 2017, a house was impacted by flooding from Spring Creek in the Kitimat/Stkine Regional District.
