On 8 July, North Shore Rescue was requested by West Vancouver PD to perform an evidence search near Trojan Horse Cache on Cypress Mountain. The search was stiid down pending further information.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 6 July, an interface fire incident was opened for an event that happened in the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality on June 21st. Incident created to help track costs incurred for public safety.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 2 July, 4 Hope SAR members came upon a male lying on the Coquihalla highway. SAR provided medical attention until BCAS arrived.

On 5 July, an incident was opened for the EOC activation in the CRD for monitoring purposed for the Tugwell Creek wildfire.

On 5 July, Columbia Valley Fire Department was issued a task to help rescue a 1 Y/O child that had fallen into the water near the Maple Bay picnic area due to their significantly faster response time.
