DANGEROUS GOODS

On 24 February 2018, the CFB Esquimalt reported that the HMCS Calgary was transferring fuel while at sea and due to an unknown factor, spilled approximately 30,000 litres of fuel to the marine at a location thought originally to be off of Constance Banks but was later reported to be from Nanoose to the east of Main Island. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer and is currently under investigation.
