FLOODING

On 08 Jan 2018, an ice jam caused flooding on the Nechako River that affected 4 homes and caused issues upstream. The City of Prince George activated their EOC to Level 1, while work was done to stabilize the flooding.

On 12 Jan 2018, the water levels in the Nechako River raised approximately 4 feet overnight and two homes were flooded in the Fraser Fort George Regional District.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 10 Jan 18, Comox Valley SAR responded at the request of the Fire Department to assist in removing a horse from a well in Fanny Bay. The horse had to be euthanized and SAR assisted in lifting the deceased animal from the well.
