BODY RECOVERY

On 12 August Hope SAR responded to recover a body in the Dogwood area of the Fraser River.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 10 August 2018, a docked barge caught fire in Surrey near the Patullo Bridge. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to media attention.

ENVIRONMENT

On 11 Aug 2018, a landslide at 3576 Hwy 99 in the Ashcroft area impacted a private residence with 6 people inside. A Geo Tech responded to assess the location.

On 11 Aug 2018, a landslide 17 km west of Ashcroft on Hwy 99 impacted the Hwy and washed a vehicle off the roadway.

On 12 Aug 2018 landslides impacted the Bonaparte Indian Band near Cache Creek. An EOC was activated to monitor the situation.

INTERFACE FIRES:

On 06 Aug, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning near Torkelsen Lake (R32182) area which resulted in an evacuation alert being issued by the Regional District Bulkley Nechako (RDBN).

On 12 Aug, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire for the Yekooche First Nation which resulted in evacuation alerts being issued. (R11498).

On 12 Aug, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire for the Copper Mountain area which resulted in evacuation alert being issued. (N72436).

On 12 Aug, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire for the Fort St. James area which resulted in an EOC activation due to the Shovel Lake fire. (R11498).

On 12 Aug, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire for the Tl'azt'en First Nation within the Bulkley Nechako Regional District for the Shovel Lake Fire (R11498).

MISCELLANEOUS

On 10 August 2018, a docked barge caught fire in Surrey near the Patullo Bridge. The Surrey EOC was activated due to media attention as well as environmental concerns regarding air quality.
