WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Feb 12 - 18, 2018

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 14 February 2018, there was a 65' fishing vessel that sunk at the Haisla Village Dock, Kitimat. The incident was initially reported with minor, if any, pollutants however details changed to several drums of material being recovered. The MOE RO then raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes with an immediate downgrade.

FLOODING

On 16 February 2018, the Central Kootenay Regional District was issued a task number to monitor a log jam on the Inanoaklin River, at Highway 6, near Fauquier.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 13 February 2018, the Youbou Fire Department was requested to assist BCAS with a medical rescue involving a subject in cardiac arrest near the head of Cowichan Lake. The patient was deceased and was handled by BCAS and the Coroner.

On 16 February 2018, a Greyhound Bus went over an embankment along Highway 97 South, 8km south of Powder King approximately 1 hour from Chetwynd. An EOC was activated by the District of Chetwynd. There were no fatalities and 11 people were mildly injured. A school bus was sent with blankets and a reception centre was opened for the affected passengers.

On 17 February 2018, Salmon Arm Rescue responded at the request of BCAS to remove a male, suffering stroke like symptoms, from his home in Deep Creek. BCAS and the Fire Department were unable to access the patient due to the heavy snowfall in the area.
