## WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Feb 05 - 11, 2018

### DANGEROUS GOODS

On 06 Feb 2018, a propane fueled truck caught fire 2 kilometres north of the Highway19 and Highway 30 junction, south of Port Hardy. The highway was closed and an evacuation area established until the fire self-extinguished a short time later. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to possible impacts to highway traffic.

On 06 Feb 2018, a 176 foot sport fishing 'mothership' with 10,000 litres of fuel onboard was reported to be sinking off April Point on Quadra Island. The Canadian Coast Guard responded with additional response resources in order to keep the vessel afloat, and additional booms were placed around the vessel to contain any potential pollution until divers arrived to affect repairs to the vessel. The incident was raised to Code 2 by the MOE RO due to the potential for pollution.

On 07 Feb 18, 150 litres of diesel spilled from a 41 foot tug at a fish farm at Port Elizabeth, Knights Inlet. Crews on scene cleaned up the majority of any recoverable product using absorbent pads and booms were deployed to keep the material from entering the pen. Some of the sheen migrated down the channel with the current. The incident was elevated to Code 2 by the MOE RO.

### LANDSLIDE

On 05 Feb 2018, the Central Kootenay Regional District was made aware of a creek that was running dry, believing a local landslide to be the cause. FLNRO was brought in to discuss options.
