**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Month; Mar 26 – 31, 2018**

**ENVIRONMENTAL**

On March 26, 2018 a number of homes were threatened by a mudslide that occurred in the District of Oliver then continued into the Regional District of Okanagan Similkameen jurisdiction.

On March 27, 2018 6 homes were threatened in the Central Okanagan Region District due to flooding of Smith Creek.

On March 27, 2018 a landslide demolished access to a FSR that leads to a water access intake for the community of Lions Bay.

On March 29, 2018 one resident in Trail was evacuated from their home due to a landslide which resulted in safety concerns.

On March 30, 2018 a mudslide occurred in the Summerland District, the FD conducted a tactical evacuation of the residence that had been impacted by the mudslide and a family of 4 was assisted by ESS.

On March 31, 2018 the Town of Oliver opened a Flooding incident due to a culvert failure.

**DANGEROUS GOODS – CODE 2**

On Mar 27, 2018 the Valley First Credit Union in Kelowna was evacuated when the occupants smelled gas. MOE RO raised this incident to CODE 2 due the evacuation. Fortis BC did not find any evidence of a leak and believe the smell may have been from a passing LNG tanker truck. Fortis cleared everyone to re-enter the building.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

On March 29, 2018 a family of three was evacuated from their home in Elkford, due to high Carbon Monoxide levels.
