DANGEROUS GOODS

On 20 Oct 2018, RCMP reported a drug lab in the community of Lumby where material was being dumped on private property and possibly impacting nearby water intakes. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to potential human health risks.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 21 Oct 2018, an incident was opened for a natural gas leak at a trailer park in Coombs, where 40+ residents were evacuated to a reception center at the Coombs Fair grounds.
