DANGEROUS GOODS:

On Aug 13, a tug boat was girded by a gravel barge it was assisting in the Northern Arm of the Fraser River. The tug boat overturned and partially submerged, posing a significant risk of fuel release. The incident was raised to a Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) for notification purposes due to possible heightened media attention and potential for environmental impacts.

On 14 Aug, a motor vehicle incident involving a truck carrying UN 1268 Class 3 PG 2 Petroleum Distillate Condensate overturned releasing oil to the ground Hwy 29 and Farrell Creek Road near Hudson's Hope. The truck and the trailer caught fire and the fire jumped highway 29 but was quickly extinguished by Fire Department on scene. The incident was raised to a Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) for notification purposes due to possible heightened media attention and potential for environmental impacts.
