BODY RECOVERY

On 23 Aug 18, Nelson SAR responded to a RCMP request to assist with a body recovery near 5 Mile Creek.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 22 Aug 18, a 5 ton truck containing sewage was involved in a 2 vehicle MVI on Highway 1, near Goldstream Provincial Park on the Malahat. The incident was raised to a Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) for notification purposes due to possible heightened media attention, road closure, fatality and potential for environmental impacts.

INTERFACE FIRES

On 20 Aug 18, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning near Darke Lake (K52803) which resulted in evacuation alerts being issued by the Okanagan Similkameen Regional District.(OSRD). The Penticton SAR team assisted with distributing the alert to residents.

On 21 Aug 18, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning near Lutz Creek (R92033) which resulted in the Daylu Dena Council activating their EOC. Evacuation alerts and orders were issued in Lower Post.

On 21 Aug 18, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning near Gotchen Lake (C42820) which resulted in an evacuation order being issued for Eureka Peak Lodge by the Cariboo Regional District.

On 22 Aug 18, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning near Wilderness Lake (C52646) which resulted in an evacuation order being issued by the Cariboo Regional District.

On 23 Aug 18, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning near Tezzeron (G51632) which resulted in an evacuation order being issued by the Bulkley Nechako Regional District.

On 23 Aug 18, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning near Edgewood Mt. O'Leary (N52566) which resulted in evacuation alerts being issued by the Central Kootenay Regional District. Kaslo SAR members assisted with distributing the alerts to citizens.

On 25 Aug 18, an incident was generated in response to a wildland interface fire burning South of Takla Lake (G51653) which resulted in evacuation alerts being issued by the Bulkley Nechako Reg District.(BNRD).
