DANGEROUS GOODS

On 31 July, a resident of Kaslo dumped 17 barrels of possible gas or diesel at the Kaslo Airport, off of Kaslo West Road. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO, because the material was dumped near a water source. Incident was immediately downgraded to Code 1.

On 01 Aug, a float plane crashed into Tyaughton lake in the Lillooet District spilling aviation fuel into the lake. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO, due to the media attention in this incident.

INTERFACE FIRE(S)

On 30 July, the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (OSRD) issued an evacuation alert after the Snowy Mountain fire (K51238) threatened homes on Chopaka Road.

On 30 July, the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (OSRD) issued an evacuation alert after the Placer Mountain fire (K61241) threatened Cathedral Lake Lodge.

On 30 July, the East Kootenay Regional District (EKRD) requested a task number and incident after an interface fire (N21615) threatened a children's camp near Blue Lake.

On 31 July, the Fraser Fort George Regional District opened their EOC in response to the McKridy Mountain wildfire (G31635) and other forest fires within their district.

On 31 July, the Lower Similkameen Indian Band opened their EOC in response to the Snowy Mountain fire (K51238).

On 01 August, an incident was opened for an interface fire at Tatelkuz Lake within the Cariboo Regional District (G41607).

On 01 August, an incident was opened for an interface fire at Quesnel Lake within the Cariboo Regional District (C31688). Evacuation alerts have been issued.

On 01 Aug, Central Kootenay Regional District (CKRD) opened their EOC in response to the HAZMAT incident (DGIR 181566 - 2018-07-31 15:48).

On 01 August, an incident was opened for an interface fire at Nadina Lake (R21721) within the Bulkley Nechako Regional District (BNRD). Evacuation alerts have been issued.

On 01 August, an incident was opened for an interface fire at Takaysie Lake (R11796) within the Bulkley Nechako Regional District (BNRD).

On 01 August, an incident was opened for an interface fire near the village of Lumby (K41809) within the North Okanagan Regional District (NORD).

On 02 Aug, An evacuation alert was issued for Canoe River Valley Area (Southwest of Valemount) area H. Interface fire (G31313)

On 02 Aug, an incident was opened in the Kitimat/Stikine Regional District for an interface fire (G51632) north of Stuart Lake near Tatla.

On 02 August, an incident was opened for the Alkali interface fire (R91947) within the Kitimat/Stikine Regional District (KSRD). Evacuation alerts have been issued.

On 01 Aug, an incident was opened in the Bulkley Nechako Regional District for an interface fire (R41945) for the Electoral Area G, NW of Babine River, being affected by the Mount Paul Fire

On 02 Aug, an incident was opened for an interface fire (91656) for the Elbow Lake Fire in the Dease Lake area.

On 02 August, an incident was opened for the Island Lake interface fire (R11921) within the Bulkley Nechako Regional District (BNRD). Evacuation alerts have been issued.

On 02 August, an incident was opened in Telegraph Creek, for an interface fire (R91947) near the Tahltan First Nation Band.
