WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT July 9 – 15 2018

BODY RECOVERY

On 9 July 18, RCMP requested Search and Rescue (SAR) assist with a body recovery at the Blueberry Paulson Bridge. SAR members from Castlegar, South Columbia, Grand Forks and Rossland responded. The body was recovered and turned over to the Coroner.

On 15 July 18, Oliver-Osoyoos SAR responded with assistance from Princeton and Keremeos SAR to conduct a body recovery from the shores of the Similkameen River. The body was successfully recovered and turned over to the Coroner.

On 15 July 18, North Peace and Tumbler Ridge SAR responded at the request of the RCMP to recover a body from the Murray River, near Tumbler Ridge. The body was successfully retrieved and turned over to the Coroner.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 11 July 18, a CN Rail train derailed on the Squamish sub. Two cars, loaded with lumber, went into Gates Lake. All other cars remained upright and no pollution was reported. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) with an immediate downgrade for notification purposes, due to the potential for media attention.

On 11 July 18, the Prince Rupert Marine Container Terminal was evacuated when staff complained of being nauseous/light-headed due to potential exposure to an unknown substance. Four people were sent to the hospital. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO until Nucor completed analysis of testing and indicated that no toxins were detected. The terminal operations resumed and the incident was downgraded.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRE

On 12 July 18, Tk'emlups First Nation (FN) activated their Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) in response to a grass fire on band land (K21118). The evacuation alerts were issued by the band due to potential risk to nearby structures.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 9 July 18, a task number was generated for the Semiahmoo FN for removal of a drifting dock after it had been secured to a pedestrian bridge that was found to have the community's main gas line running across it.

On 12 July 18, Sparwood and Elkford SAR teams responded to the Josephine Falls area outside of Elkford to rescue a hiker's dog that had gone over the cliff.

On 13 July 18, Dawson Creek Fire Department requested SAR assistance to rescue a dog that fell down a cliff somewhere in the area of the Kiskitnewna River. As exact location of the dog could not be determined, SAR opted not to respond.
