

WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Mar 19-25 2018

ENVIRONMENTAL

On 21 & 22 Mar 2018 the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (OSRD) opened incidents in Oliver, Keremeos and Naramata due to heavy rains causing flooding throughout the district.

On Mar 22, 2018 West Kelowna opened their EOC to level 1 due to flooding events in the area.

On Mar 22, 2018 Penticton FD members responded to a landslide at the request of the EPC and assisted in clean up and traffic control.

On Mar 22, 2018 Kaleden FD members responded to a landslide at the request of the EPC and assisted in clean up and traffic control.

On Mar 23, 2018 the city of Armstrong declared a state of emergency due to a large number of homes threatened and impacted by large amounts of water causing local streams to overflow.

On Mar 23, 2018 Vernon activated their EOC to Level 1 due to overland flooding impacting the NW area of the district.

On Mar 23, 2018 the District of Barriere experienced a rockfall onto a roadway and requested a Geotechnical inspection of the slope to ensure the area was safe for passing traffic.

DANGEROUS GOODS – CODE 2

On Mar 20, 2018, a natural gas meter was sheared off at a hotel on Silver Star Mountain Resort. MOE RO raised this incident to CODE 2 status due to the evacuation of people from the hotel and adjacent structures. Fortis BC has repaired the damaged natural gas line and stopped the leak. Everyone was eventually allowed back in.

On Mar 22, 2018 a motor vehicle incident on Hwy 2 near the BC/Alberta border resulted in a semi-truck transporting hydrochloric acid overturning in a ditch and the main tank becoming punctured spilling an estimated 17 cubic metres of 23% Hydrochloric acid into the snow covered ditch, Incident was raised to CODE 2 as a result of the spill.
