WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 21-27 May 2018

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 24 May, a motor vehicle incident occurred in Goldstream Provincial Park on Highway 1 near Finlayson Arm road resulting in an overturned transport tanker truck carrying 2300 litres of furnace oil that was reported to be leaking from the rear hatch to the ditch. The truck was also loaded with 2200 litres of gasoline and had 160 litres of diesel fuel in its saddle tanks. The highway was closed in both directions. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO who attended the site along with Hazmat and Fire crews to help mitigate the spill.

FLOODING

On 22 May, an incident was opened in response to flooding on Little Shuswap Lake within the Adams Lake Indian Band community near Chase.

On 23 May, an incident was opened to activate an EOC in preparation for possible flooding on the Samahquam First Nation in Squamish Lillooet Regional District.

On 23 May, an incident was opened for the Little Shuswap Lake Indian Band in response to flooding.

LANDSLIDES

On 26 May, an incident was opened for a landslide at Kault Hill in Salmon Arm that affected one home.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 21 May, Quesnel SAR responded and rescued a dog that had been swept into a fast moving river, went over the falls and was stranded on the opposite bank, at the base of a 35 foot cliff.

On 23 May, Nicola Valley SAR responded and rescued a cat that was caught in a tree, surrounded by flood waters at the Rotary Park in Merritt.

On 24 May, the Vernon Fire Department Rope Team responded and rescued an injured 64 year old male who fell through a staircase opening at a construction site.

On 30 May, ESS support was provided to an individual whose boat/residence and all possessions were lost in a fire.

On 30 May Central Cariboo SAR provided a "medical assist" to the RCMP.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRES

On 23 May, the Squamish Lillooet Regional District activated their EOC in response to an interface fire (K70348) north of McGillivray Falls.

On 24 May, a task number was generated for the PECC to cover response and support activities for the 2018 fire season.

On 25 May, an incident was generated for the Thompson Nicola Regional District due to an interface fire (K20351) near Allie Lake.

On 26 May, the Peace River Regional District was provided a task number following the tactical evacuation of 100 residents in the community of Nig Creek that was threatened by an interface fire (G80340).
