### **Dangerous Goods CODE 2**

On 07 May, MoE was notified about a barge that sank on the South Thompson River near Kamloops. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to CODE 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes due to possible heightened media attention and potential for environmental impacts.

On 07 May, MoE was notified of a hydraulic oil and diesel spill on 8<sup>th</sup> Ave in Aldergrove. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to CODE 2 (urgent status) as the material entered Homestead Creek which is fish bearing waters.

On 09 May, a utility contractor hit a 2" Fortis natural gas line in Pitt Meadows. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to an evacuation of residents from a nearby apartment building.
