On 7 Oct, 2018 a gasoline odour in the vicinity of the Trans-mountain pipeline in Surrey was reported to Fire who then notified Ministry of Environment. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to media attention.
