## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 24 – 30 Dec 2018**

### **DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 24 Dec, the Ministry of Environment Spill Response Officer upgraded a diesel spill in the Squamish area originally reported on 20 Dec to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to potential impact to environment (upwelling diesel) and possible media attention. TASK 194922

On 24 Dec, the Ministry of Environment Spill Response Officer upgraded a diesel spill with potential of 3000-4000 liters on the Fraser River in the Richmond area to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to due to potential impact to environment (unconfirmed amount being released from vessel) and possible media attention. TASK 194978

On 29 Dec, the Ministry of Environment Spill Response Officer upgraded a well head blowout involving sweet gas and water in the Fort St John area to a Code 2 (urgent status). Crews evacuated site and roadblocks were placed to prevent entry into immediate area. TASK 195076

On 30 Dec, the Ministry of Environment Spill Response Officer responded to a semi truck carrying frozen meat in the Clearwater area. The spill was upgraded to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to media attention as the trucks fuel tanks were leaking diesel into the North Thompson River. TASK 195077

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 26 Dec, an incident was opened in response to a sink hole opening up in the Seawatch Lane area of Sechelt that has the potential to cut off access to residences in the area. TASK 195011

On 30 Dec, an incident was opened to monitor the possible impact of a diesel spill to drinking water in the North Thompson River. TASK 195077
