DANGEROUS GOODS

On 22 March, 2019, a semi truck collided with a small passenger vehicle resulting in a fatality and a spill of red wine in Penticton. The highway was closed for investigation purposes. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to heightened media attention. TASK 196539

On 23 March, 2019, a CP Rail train with 5 propane cars derailed at the Port Coquitlam Rail Yard. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to possible heightened media attention. TASK 196570

On 18 Mar, an incident was issued for flooding preparation in the Cherry Creek area of the TNRD (Thompson Nicola Regional District). TASK 196421

On 18 Mar, an incident was generated for flooding in the Cache Creek area. TASK 196488

On 18 Mar, an incident was generated for flooding of Lopez Creek into Cache Creek. TASK 196488

On 21 Mar, an incident was generated for a mudslide that occurred in the Sobotka Road area of Lillooet that caused flooding damage to one residence. TASK 196524

On Mar 22, an incident was generated for flooding preparation in Electoral Area I in the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (RDOS). TASK 190029

On Mar 22, an incident was generated for a land slide 4 miles west of Keremeos. EOC was activated to level 1 at that time. TASK 196547

On Mar 23, an incident was generated for a landslide on Highway 29 south towards Tumbler Ridge in the Peace River Regional District. A residence is being threatened by the Sukunka River and a family of 2 adults and 7 children self-evacuated. TASK 196566.

On Mar 24, an incident was generated for flooding in the Soda Creek Road area of the Cariboo Regional District. TASK 196580.
