BODY RECOVERY

On 24 June, Whistler SAR assisted RCMP with a body recovery on the Cheakamus River in Whistler. X-REF SAR 200356.

On 25 June, Terrace SAR assisted RCMP with a body recovery near Terrace.

FLOODING

On 23 June, an incident was opened for FFGRD in the Robson Valley after a beaver dam was at risk of becoming overtopped which is potentially threatening 20 - 30 residents downstream.

On 23 June, an incident was opened in response to flooding on Dominion Creek in McBride

On 24 June, an incident was opened for the Village of Valemount to open their EOC in response to localized flooding which was impacting their water treatment plant.

On 24 June, an incident was opened for the City of Quesnel to move municipal resources from property affected by flooding.

On 24 June, an incident was opened for FFGRD in response to flooding on Garrett Road, in McBride which resulted in a tactical evacuation of residents.

On 25 June, an incident was opened in response to potential flooding on Farrell Road, in Prince George. The EOC was activated to a level 1.

On 26 June, an incident was opened for freshet flooding from the Fraser River in the Lheidli T'Enneh FN.

On 26 June, an incident was opened for FFGRD for freshet flooding and sandbags for residents on Hinkleman rd in the Robson Valley.

On 26 June, an incident was opened for the Kent District's EOC to provide freshet preparedness support.

On 26 June, an incident was opened for flooding from Shuswap Lake in the Salmon Arm District that resulted in home owners being forced from their residence.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 22 June, an incident was opened due to police standoff with a male and a weapon in a Vancouver apartment complex.

On 23 June, a vehicle drove into a residence, displacing 2 people in the Vernon area.
