WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Aug 03 – Aug 09, 2020

BODY RECOVERY

On 03 Aug, Cranbrook SAR's rope team and Kimberley SAR's swift water rescue teams responded for a body recovery in the St Mary River near Wycliffe.

On 08 Aug, Shuswap SAR responded to assist the RCMP and Coroner with recovering a deceased occupant from a motor vehicle incident in the Chase area.

LANDSLIDE

On 06 Aug, an incident was opened by the East Kootenay EPC due to a potential landslide between Highway 95a and the St. Mary River. Although no homes or infrastructure was at risk, the slump that was failing was in a recreational area that posed a risk to public safety.

On 08 Aug, an incident was opened in Penticton for a landslide that was impacting a residence on Heather Road. A SOLE was being considered, once more details were learned and an Order for 2 residences and an Alert for 4 other properties could be actioned at that time.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 03 Aug, the Port Renfrew Fire Department responded to assist BCAS with an elderly female that had fallen at Botanical Beach and was injured. The team brought the subject to the parking lot where she was transferred to ambulance.

On 04 Aug, RCMSAR Shuswap Rescue 1 was issued a task number to assist in transporting Sicamous Fire and BCWS personnel to Court Side Point on Shuswap Lake to assist with a campfire that had turned into a wildfire.

On 05 Aug, ESS was provided for residents evacuated from an apartment building in Vancouver, that was damaged when a vehicle ran into the building.

On 08 Aug, Shirley Fire and Rescue responded to assist BCAS with a patient who suffered a fall on the trail to Sombrio Beach, near Port Renfrew, as BCAS did not have a unit in the area.

On 09 Aug, Chilliwack River Valley Fire Department responded to assist BCAS with a patient who suffered a motorcycle accident on the Chipmunk FSR. TASK 212644

INTERFACE FIRE

On 03 Aug, the City of Kimberley opened their EOC to level 1 in response to a fast-moving wildfire (N10856) burning just outside their boundaries.

On 03 Aug, a task number was issued to the Okanagan Similkameen Regional District when their EOC was activated in response to wildfire (K60864) that prompted an evacuation alert for Allison Lake community.

On 06 Aug, the Okanagan Similkameen Regional District activated their EOC with support from Penticton ESS, BC Wildfire, Penticton Fire and RCMP. 40 homes were tactically evacuated due to a fire in the area of Highway 97 and Sage Mesa.
