BODY RECOVERY

On 13 Aug, Campbell River SAR assisted RCMP with a body recovery in the Nootka Sound/Gold River area.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 13 August, an incident was opened after an MVI resulted in an estimated 20 liters of paint being spilled onto the TCH just west of Revelstoke. The highway was shut down and some paint entered a nearby stream and the incident was raised to a Code 2 (urgent status) by MOE RO due to potential environmental impact and media attention.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 10 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire outside of Kimberley (C11005) for the community to establish an EOC.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 14 August, an incident was opened to provide tasking to the Cherry Creek Fire Department to provide support to BCAS regarding an injured subject trapped behind a locked gate.
