WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Aug 17 – 23, 2020

BODY RECOVERY

On 18 Aug, RCMP requested Columbia Valley SAR, to assist in a body recovery in Canal Flats, possibly associated with a previous SAR incident in the area.

On 19 Aug, RCMP and BC Coroner requested Terrace SAR to assist in a body recovery in the SK Creek FSR area after a helicopter crashed.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 19 August, an incident was opened after a motor vehicle accident resulted in unknown amount of diesel fuel being spilled from a B-train on Highway 16. The incident was raised to a Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media and environmental issues.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 18 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire (V61180) in the Capital Regional District in their watershed.

On 18 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire (K51287) in the Okanagan Falls, Regional District of Okanagan Similkameen.

On 18 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire South of the US border (K51291) near The Town of Osoyoos.

On 18 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire North of Beaverdell (N61276) Regional District of Kootenay Boundary

On 18 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire (K51287) near Heritage Hill in the City of Penticton.

On 19 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire (N21257) near Canal Flats/Finley area for the East Kootenay Regional District.

On 19 Aug, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire (V31176) which is causing a potential blockage in Catalin Creek with the potential to cause flooding, from forecasted heavy rains, around Lillooet Lakes Estates.

On 22 Aug, an incident was opened for the Central Kootenay Regional District for an interface fire (N21250) affecting the community of Vallican.

FLOODING

On 23 Aug, an incident was opened for flooding in the Takla FN area from Hudson Bay Creek.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 18 Aug, an incident was opened after a family traveling through Burns Lake on their way to Vancouver for medical treatment, suffered a severe motor vehicle incident and needed assistance for the night. ESS responded and provided lodging.

On 20 Aug, a task number was given to Lake Cowichan Fire Dept for a medical rescue on Youbou Road that happened on July 5th. There was an 86 year old male that appeared to have a stroke and Fire needed to unlock two gates to gain access to the patient for BC Ambulance.

TORNADO

On 21 Aug, ESS responded to assist 6 known occupants displaced when their residences on 88th Street and 107A Avenue, were damaged by a tornado that touched down in Fort St. John. TASK 212936
