FLOODING

On Dec 16, an incident was generated to track localized flooding caused by an ice jam near the Delwood Road area in the Bulkley Nechako Regional District.

On Dec 16, an incident was generated to track localized flooding caused by ice jams along the Nechako River in the Vanderhoof District.

LANDSLIDE

On Dec 16, an incident was generated to record a significant landslide in Bute Inlet. The incident occurred in late November and is believed to have impacted Homalco First Nations territory and caused significant damage to salmon bearing waterways.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 15 Dec, a TASK was issued for Emergency Support Services (ESS) to respond and assist 1 person impacted by a propane tank explosion at an apartment building in Nelson.

On 17 Dec, a TASK was issued for ESS to support evacuees from a hazardous structure in Port Alberni.

On 20 Dec, a TASK was issued to the Nanaimo Fire Department to dispatch their Fire Rescue team to a motorhome with unknown residency that had caught fire in the Nanaimo Lakes area.

BODY RECOVERY

On 17 Dec, a TASK was issued for Vernon SAR to recover a body on Turtle Mountain.
