WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Jan 20-26, 2020

AVALANCHE

On 24 Jan 2020, an avalanche was reported to have occurred on the Trans Canada Highway between Three Valley Gap and Revelstoke.

FLOODING

On 23 Jan 2020, Coquitlam First Nations received notification of a potential flooding incident as a result of BC Hydro releasing water from a dam upstream.

LANDSLIDE

On 23 Jan 2020, a private retaining wall failed and caused a landslide that affected 8 adjacent properties in Burnaby. These properties needed to be evacuated due to safety concerns.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 24 Jan 2020, Ucluelet activated their EOC to conduct monitoring and planning in response to construction blocking the highway at Kennedy Lake.

On 24 Jan 2020, Tofino activated their EOC to conduct a community resource survey, community messaging, planning, and liaising with emergency responders for urgent transport in response to construction blocking the highway.

On 26 Jan 2020, Kaslo SAR was requested by BCAS for a lift assist of a patient. SAR was stood down immediately when BCAS crew successfully removed the subject.

SEVERE STORM

On 20 Jan 2020, Cheam First Nation in Chilliwack opened a warming centre to support the winter storm event.
