**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT March 2 to March 8 2020**

**DANGEROUS GOODS CODE 2**

On 05 Mar, a CN rail train carrying various materials derailed on the Fraser Sub near Prince George. 6 rail cars derailed causing the release of petroleum coke into a creek which exits Eaglet Lake. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to potential environmental impact and heightened media attention.
