FLOODING

On Jan 03, Mount Waddington Regional District requested an incident be opened for isolated flooding in the Coal harbor Road area.

On Jan 03, Mount Waddington Regional District requested an incident be opened for isolated flooding on Teeta Road within Quatsino First Nation.

POWER OUTAGE

On Jan 02, ESS – Columbia Shuswap Regional District activated a warming center in response to 20 – 30 families impacted by an extended power outage in the Silver Creek area.

On Jan 03, RCMP requested Kaslo SAR perform welfare checks on 25 plus community members in Johnson Landing that have been impacted by extended power / communications outages due to a storm event.

On Jan 03, Columbia Shuswap Regional District activated a warming center in response to 200 homes impacted by an extended power outage in the Lakeview Centre Anglemont area.

On Jan 03, Neskonlith First Nation activated their EOC to Level 1 in response to power outages and road closures within the community.

On Jan 4, Central Coast Regional District activated a warming center in response to an ongoing avalanche that has caused power outages and road closures in Bella Coola affecting the Nuxalk First Nation.

On Jan 4, Little Shuswap Indian Band provided ESS support for a pregnant woman who was without power. Due to the subject's condition, ESS assistance was provided for 1 night.

MISCELLANEOUS

On Dec 31, Fraser Valley Regional District advised of a landslide with the potential to impact 7 homes in the Chilliwack area. A Geo Tech responded and situation stabilized without evacuations.
