

FORM OF HEAT - FH

Form of Heat refers to the energy which associates the Igniting Object with the Material First Ignited.

Notes: a) If lightning is involved in a fire, code under 3000.

b) In the case of an exposure fire, code under 1000, 4000 or 6000 as applicable.

- 1000 Spark, ember (includes flying brand or spark shower)
- 2000 Spark, electrical (includes arc, discharge) (excludes static electrical spark classified under 3000)
- 3000 Spark, static electrical (includes lightning)
- 4000 Direct flame
- 5000 Friction heat
- 6000 Hot object (direct heat by conduction or radiation, no direct contact with flames or embers)
- 7000 Spontaneous or chemical causation
- 8000 Heat from smoker's material (excludes match, lighter, classified under 4000 when such are used other than in conjunction with smoker's material)
