

TRANSMISSION OF ALARM - AL

Transmission of Alarm to Fire Department is the means by which the fire department was first notified.

If the method of transmission of the alarm to the fire department is known but is not included in the classifications listed below, code as 0009. If the fire department was not notified or if there was such a delay that the fire department was unable to effectively combat the fire, code as 6000.

- 1000 911
- 2000 Coded signal municipal fire alarm system (included are telegraph or telephone systems, radio systems, and auxiliary connection to them (direct connection between building fire alarm system and fire department))
- 3000 Private fire alarm system (includes signal/alarm received indirectly through a private system)
- 4000 Radio
- 5000 Direct verbal report to a fire station
- 6000 No alarm received (includes alarms when delayed resulting in late or no response)
- 7000 Telephone direct to fire department other than 911
