

What's New: Wildland Urban Interface Wildfire Risk Reduction Plans 2024

Wildland Urban Interface Wildfire Risk Reduction Plans (herein referred to as **WRR Plans**) are the new iteration of **Tactical Plans**. The name change better reflects the purpose of these plans and eliminates confusion with operational response plans.

What's new in the Guide and Standard:

- Addition of visual to clarify differences between WUI WRR Plan and CWRP
