

What's New: Wildland Urban Interface Wildfire Risk Reduction Plans

Wildland Urban Interface Wildfire Risk Reduction Plans (herein referred to as **WRR Plans**) are the new iteration of **Tactical Plans**. The name change better reflects the purpose of these plans and eliminates confusion with operational response plans.

What's new in the Guide and Standard:

- Edits to document arrangement to better align with the development process of a WRR Plan.
- Details on the roles and responsibilities of the WUI WRR Plan 'Project Team'.
- Further guidance on coordination with other land management authorities.
- Edits and updates to terminology and links.
- Removed glossary to limit discrepancies between different BCWS documents - please refer to BCWS Glossary or most recent CIFFC Glossary.
- Further explanation around the definition, purpose and development of all planning and fuel management unit types
 - Separation of Non-Productive units from Assess-Monitor units.
- Consolidation of references to fuel management and treatment principles – please refer to the [2023 Fuel Management Practices Guide](#) on the Tools for Fuel Management Webpage.
- Clarity on how WUI WRR Plans aligns and interacts with other plans.
- Further clarity on the use of additional modelling tools.
- Further clarity on the standard of deliverables associated with the development of WRR Plans.
- Updates to the Output Table template and Spatial deliverable Standard

What's new with the Output Table:

- Edits to document arrangement and formatting and further explanation around content requirements
- Removal and addition of columns
