

# COVID-19 Relief and Recovery Funding for Public Libraries One-time Grant Allocation Summary March 2022

#### Overview

B.C.'s public libraries play an important role in tackling today's challenges, strengthening inclusive communities and sustaining economic growth. This \$8 million COVID-19 Relief and Recovery funding is distributed between 71 public libraries, 6 library federations and 3 library service partners by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs through the Public Libraries Branch.
