


Begbie Falls Recreation Site Campground Campsite Information

Begbie Falls Recreation Site campground was built in 2020. Nestled in amongst a large network of mountain bike trails, climbing walls, walking trails leading down to the Columbia River and a highlight being the Begbie Falls waterfalls, this site is a hub for many visitors to the Revelstoke area.






Background:

This recreation site is approximately 15 minutes from downtown Revelstoke, with a 2 kilometer stretch on a forest service road. Typically, the site is filled with outdoor enthusiasts who come to the area to mountain bike, hike and climb and pursue other outdoor activities. The infrastructure is still new as the site is only 4 years old.

Facilities:



Begbie Falls Recreation Site has:

- 26 Campsites
- 26 fire rings
- 26 picnic tables
- 3 outhouses
- -26 number posts

<u>Scope</u>

Term: The term of the agreement would begin with 1 year (season), with the option to extend for additional years after a successful season.

Operations: May 12th to September 30th

Camping Fees: \$15/party/night and \$7.50/party/night for seniors or person with a disability

Service Requirements:

The Site Operator's responsibilities will include the following:

- Site and facility work, including construction and repairs, especially in the early season to clean-up after the winter season.
- Cleaning facilities throughout the season, including daily cleaning and sanitizing of toilets.
- Interacting with visitors by collecting fees, informing and encouraging compliance to the site rules, providing information, etc.
- Assessing and mitigating hazardous situations, should they arise.

• Communicating with enforcement personnel (RCMP, Conservation Officers and Natural Resource Officers) to report conflicts with people or wildlife. • Taking initiative to improve the general condition of the site, while maintaining and adhering to Recreation Sites and Trails BC standards.

• Weed whacking, mowing grass, raking, garbage disposal, painting, etc.

- Reporting to the District Recreation Officer/Recreation Technician regarding visitor use, finances, and project work.
- Public services/outreach.
