

# ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 105 OF THE FOREST PRACTICES CODE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA ACT



I, Tony Wideski, District Manager, Cranbrook Forest District, Order that within the Sylvan Lake area of the Cranbrook Community Forest Interpretive Forest Site located immediately east of the City of Cranbrook, (Legal Description attached):

- a) No person shall use a motor vehicle except on designated roads as shown on the map in this order.
- b) No person shall enter or use except between the hours of 5:00 AM and 10:00 PM (local time).
- c) No person shall cause or permit the burning of an open fire.

This order is made pursuant to Section 105, subsection (1) (b) of the *Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act* and is effective June 16, 1998. It rescinds and replaces the previous order dated May 11, 1998.

A breach of this order constitutes an offence.
