

By Authority of Section 105(1)(b) of the Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act, and having determined that certain recreation resources within the subject Provincial Forest lands are in need of protection, I hereby order (or declare) that, effective October 1, 1998, the following restrictions and prohibitions apply, as described to the area shown on the attached map.

Overnight use of the Ole Sandbert Hut is prohibited. Evening use of the Hut (from one hour after sunset to 1 a.m. local time) may be authorized in writing by the District Manager, Columbia Forest District.

This order remains in force until further notice.

Note: "A person who contravenes an enactment by doing an act that forbids, or omitting to do an act that requires to be done, commits an offense against the enactment".
