
**PLACER MOUNTAIN TO BORDER LAKE MOTORIZED RECREATION
REGULATION ORDER.**

**By Order of the District Managers, Penticton and Merritt Forest Districts, British
Columbia Ministry of Forests.**


The Placer mountain to Border Lake Motorized Recreation Regulated Area, as described in Exhibit "A" map dated February 28, 1997, is closed to the operation of motorized recreation vehicles, including off road and all terrain vehicles, except snowmobiles, between January 1st. and December 31st. annually, except on those roads and trails specifically identified in the above noted Exhibit "A" Map, and as may from time to time be designated. This Order is made pursuant to Section 105(1)(b) of the Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act, and takes effect June 1, 1997.



This Order is issued in response to local concerns for the protection of sensitive alpine and sub-alpine areas, wildlife and wildlife habitat and designation of the area for non-motorized recreation uses.
