The letter is to inform you that the Williams Lake River Valley area has been restricted to motorized recreation, pursuant to Section 58 (1)(b) of the *Forest and Range Practices Act*.

This order cancels and replaces the section 105 (1) of the *Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act*, issued on November 29th, 1996.

The map attached describes the area within the Williams Lake River Valley. The purpose of the order is to allow safe passage and enjoyment of the trail by the public by a Non-Motorized means of travel. The following vehicles will be exempted; service vehicles, emergency evacuation vehicles, resource management vehicles, residential access and uses permitted under other Acts.

Signage indicating the regulation changes will be placed at determined locations in the area.
